Action Submit the required documents for your I-20	Time Period January-June	Tips To be eligible to receive your I-20, you must accept our offer of admission and submit the required financial documents, which should be dated within 9 months of the date you intend to begin your studies. Look for scholarship notification	January-April	Students who have been selected to receive scholarships will be notified via email. No separate application is required.

Action Sign up for on-campus housing and dining	Time Period Mid-February-Mid July	Tips Access the housing and dining contracts after you have activated your NetID through the Enrollment Pathway at admissions.rutgers.edu/pathway . (Your NetID is a unique identifier that will allow you access to many electronic services, including your email.)
MARCH		
Action Register for International Student Orientation	Time Period March-August	Tips International Student Orientation is a mandatory program held in August, which includes shopping trips and a visit to Philadelphia! Register at ois.camden.rutgers.edu/orientation
Action Register for Placement Tests (if required) *All first-year students are required to take the Math Placement test.	March-August	You may take placement tests remotely through online administration. More information about remote placement test is available on the Enrollment Pathway. If you are in the U.S., you may register to take placement tests on campus: newstudents.camden.rutgers.edu/testing_registration Placement testing will also be offered on campus 2 days prior to International Student Orientation.

Action Obtain your I-20, pay your SEVIS I-901 fee, and apply for a visa	Time Period April-July	Tips Once you have received your I-20 from Rutgers, pay your SEVIS I-901 fee at fmjfee.com and apply for your visa at a US embassy or consulate. *Students attending an institution in the U.S. should submit the Foreign Student Adviser's Report which can be found here: http://ois.camden.rutgers.edu/incoming_transfer
Action Complete the online orientation.	April-August	Tips To complete the Online Orientation, please visit https://orientation1.camden.rutgers.edu . (You will need your NETID and password to login.)
MAY		
If you are currently in the US, attend a student orientation, advising and registration program (SOAR)	May-August	Tips Get assistance in selecting courses. An academic advising and registration program will also be offered to students during the week of International Student Orientation.
Receive your credit evaluation	May-August	If you are a New Jersey county college transfer student, visit njtransfer.org to get a general idea of the transferability of your courses.

Action Prepare for your arrival in the US.	Time Period June-August	Tips For information to assist you in preparing for your arrival, check out our Pre-Arrival guidebook or visit ice.gov/sevis/students .
July		
Action Submit your immunization records	Time Period July 15	Tips Submit your pre-entrance immunization record to the Student Health Center by July 15. For more information, visit admissions.rutgers.edu/pathway .
Check your term bill	Mid-late July	Term bills will be available online at studentabc.rutgers.edu beginning mid-late July. Payment due dates begin in August.
August		
Action Pay your term bill.	Time Period August	Tips The due date will be displayed on your term bill. Term bills can be paid by credit card (online only, Visa not accepted), check, money order or bank draft by mail or in person at the Student Accounting Office.
Receive your housing assignment and roommate's contact information.	Early August	Your housing assignment is provided by email along with your roommate's contact information.
